

# Adventure Extension Tour

# 08 to 11 September 2025

## **ITINERARY - 4 DAYS / 3 NIGHTS**

To experience the true Jordan, one must see its nature. Hike in the Petra area, meet the Bedouins out in Wadi Rum, take a dip in the Dead Sea, and hike through canyons and gorges on this exciting extension.

#### Day 1: 08 September – Little Petra and Monastery hike

The day begins with a hike by the awe-inspiring "Little Petra," setting the stage for an unforgettable adventure. The expert tour guide will enrich you with knowledge about the area and prepare you for the journey ahead. From there, you'll venture through the viewpoints of Wadi Mataha and Jabal al-Khubtha, guiding you to Petra's lesser-known back entrances. After exploring the Monastery, you'll make your way down to the iconic Treasury and emerge through the magnificent Siq.

Meals included: Breakfast, and Lunch.

### Day 2: 09 September – Wadi Rum Desert

Vast, echoing, and god-like is how T.E. Lawrence described the Wadi Rum desert, also known as Valley of the Moon, and now it's your turn to get lost in this stunning desert and sleep under the stars. After breakfast you will leave Petra and be driven to the magnificent Wadi Rum desert. It was here the British army officer T. E. Lawrence gathered the Arab tribes to revolt against the Ottoman Turkish rule during World War I, a story that became world-famous in the movie "Lawrence of Arabia." From the Wadi Rum Visitors Center, you will be moved from a bus to a jeep and go on a tour through the desert, past sand dunes and incredible rock formations. After a cup of tea made by Bedouins, the tour ends with dinner and an overnight in a Bedouin Camp with the choice of a Bedouin Tent or a Star Tent. Extra cost to stay in a Star Tent: \$161 pp twin share or \$323 single.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

#### Day 3: 10 September – Wadi Mujib and Amman

After breakfast you will be driven to Wadi Mujib gorge, in many ways similar to the Siq in Petra - narrow and with towering cliffs rising on both sides. Through the gorge runs the Mujib River and this unique nature reserve is home to over 400 species of plants, more than a 100 species of birds and animals like the Nubian Ibex, Red Fox, Hyena, Jackal, Wild Cat, Caracal, Badger, Mongoose, Wolf and Arabian Leopard.

You will see the Wadi Mujib on a 2-hour hike, wade through water up to the base of a large waterfall. Along the way, you'll climb several smaller waterfalls with the help of fixed ropes, ladders, and a guide. One you reach the waterfall; you can swim in the pool at its base. Please note that while this hike is rated easy-moderate, the depth of the pools can vary depending on seasonal conditions. Thus, anyone going on this trail must be at least 18 years old and capable of swimming. Overnight Amman. *Meals included: Breakfast and lunch.* 

### Day 4 – 11 September – Farewell Jordan

Hotel check out is at 12pm. You will be transferred from Amman to Queen Alia International Airport. Three transfers are arranged which get you to the airport at 5am, 1pm and 6pm. It's possible, for an extra charge, to book a private transfer if the above scheduled group transfers don't fit your onward journey. *Meals included: Breakfast.*
