### 8KM RUNNING COPENHAGEN SPECIAL TOUR - 22 OCT 2025

A specially crafted running tour has been arranged for Polar Circle Marathon participants that you can book if you would like some sightseeing in Copenhagen and to stretch your legs before heading off to Greenland. The relatively short distances, the fantastic sights, and the vibe of the city makes it perfect for sightseeing whilst running.

The running tour will last for around 1.5hrs starting at 3:30pm from Rådhuspladsen (City Hall Square) and you will cover approx. 8kms. From the statue of world-famous storyteller H.C. Andersen you head to the main sights in Copenhagen including the Parliament, the Queen's castle and the Little Mermaid. The route has been planned with the beautiful scenery of Copenhagen in mind and you will be running along the canals and the harbor as well as some of Copenhagen's many parks. This tour is very informal and run only in smaller groups so there is plenty of time to ask questions. Pace: 5-6 minutes per kilometer.

Beginning of the Northern Lights tour, you set off into the backcountry by bus, and find yourself in total darkness beneath Kangerlussuad's starry skies. Shades of green, red, blue and violet are likely. Colour variations are due to the type of gas particles that collide, as well as the altitude at which they collide. Oxygen molecules at lower altitudes of up to 241km produce the most common colour, a yellowy green; then deepen to shades of red above 241km high. Nitrogen produces blue hues at altitudes up to 96.5km and vivid purples above 96.5km. NB: Northern Lights tour is weather dependent, and a full refund will be given if the tour is cancelled. Tour runs 8pm to 10pm or later.

Drive through the township of Kangerlussuaq, admire the raw beauty of the surrounding area, and meet authentic Greenlandic sled dogs. A former American air base, Kangerlussuaq is now the main airport of Greenland. The guide will share exciting origin stories, of the base, talk about the Second World War and the Cold War and how the area developed into a modern international airport. The area around Kangerlussuaq has Greenland's longest road and part of it will be used to drive to the harbour to enjoy views of the beautiful fjord. You will also visit the Greenlandic sled dog kennels. With some luck you may spot a musk oxen during this 3.5 hour scenic drive.

### RUSSELL GLACIER

Kangerlussuaq enjoys the unique pleasure of being the only place in Greenland where you can drive to the Ice Sheet. You will board a tundra coach - a special 4WD vehicle designed to handle ice, rocks, and uneven ground - and then drive partially off-road on the fascinating route to the magnificent Russell Glacier. The drive will take approximately 1.5 hours, and along the way you'll be on the lookout for wildlife such as reindeer and musk oxen. The glacier is an impressive sight, with vertical walls of ice that rise as high as 60 meters. Even though you will not walk on the glacier itself, you will have a chance to hike along the glacier's edge to truly appreciate its immense power. You'll get close enough for some great photo and video opportunities before heading back to Kangerlussuaq.
