



Polar Circle Marathon Ilulissat Optional Excursions



MEET THE SLED DOGS – 28 & 29 OCT 2025

DURATION: 1.5 HOURS STARTS 4PM OR 5PM

The excursion begins at Arctic Living where Flemming, a local musher, will meet the group outside next to his dogs. He will talk about raising the pups, the expeditions he has been on, and mushing itself. You'll also be able to observe the dogs, but please remember that these are working animals and not pets - they are not meant for cuddling. This excursion does not include dog sled riding, but will, unlike a dog sled riding tour, give a very thorough and interesting look into the history and life of dog sled mushers in Greenland.

NOTE: 12 people can join at the same time, so the exact time and date will be decided according to the number of participants. Tour is non-refundable.

SAIL TO OQAATSUT SETTLEMENT – 29 OCT 2025

The tour starts by boat from Ilulissat to Oqaatsut; a 30-minute boat tour sailing among the gigantic icebergs from the Ilulissat Icefjord on their path north of Ilulissat. On arrival in Oqaatsut, the guide will take you on a tour of the settlement where you will see the school, church, and fish factory of Oqaatsut. The guide will tell you all about living in a small settlement-community and the history of Oqaatsut. The settlement tour ends at Restaurant H8 Explorer where lunch will be served made from local ingredients. You will then have time to explore the area for an hour or two before the boat sails back to Ilulissat.

The route back to Ilulissat is very scenic with the 70 million year old volcanic Disko Island to the west and the green mainland to the east. Tour is non-refundable.
